Key to Assessment Types

SA (Summative Assessment)	This could be an end of chapter/unit test, substantial piece of extended writing or other significant assessment which captures learning and understanding
PPE (Pre Public Exam)	Set by the exam boards or other nationally available provider
School Test	A rigorous assessment, carried out under test conditions, mark scheme used and outcomes internally moderated and benchmarked
NGRT (New Group Reading Test)	An online test which identifies a student's current reading age
DRET Test	A test which will be used in all secondary DRET schools
PG (Predicted Grade)	The grade that you think a student is likely to achieve at the end of the course
ATL (Attitude to Learning)	See descriptors for specific criteria
